ENROLMENT POLICY



Darlington Primary is highly regarded, attracting many families from nearby suburbs, which can sometimes place strain on school resources. As a designated local intake school, it's crucial to understand the enrolment process and eligibility requirements.

Submit the form along with all required supporting documents to the school. Our principal will review your application, and you will be contacted promptly in accordance with Department of Education guidelines. Successful applicants will receive an enrolment package.

Parents must ensure all information provided is accurate, as per the Education Act 1999.

Checklist Supporting Documents for Enrolment Application: (Originals to be provided)

Proof of Residence x 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Settlement notice, Sales Deed or Shire Rates invoice and/or; • Signed tenancy agreement or Letter from Landlord/Real Estate Agent with tenancy agreement to follow (minimum 6 month left on lease) and/or; • Electricity, gas and/or internet account.
Proof of Age	Full birth certificate. If both parents were born overseas, we are also required to view your child's Australian passport as proof of citizenship/residency.
Students with visas	Overseas-born students must be naturalised Australians or hold a valid visa to enrol. We need to see the passport and visa of both the primary visa holder (parent) and the student at the time of application. A meeting with the principal may be required to assess the student's educational needs.
Immunisation Statement	A current copy of your child's My Gov Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) Immunisation History Statement <i>no more than two months old.</i>
Medical Information	Information relating to health or medical conditions, health care plans, disability and/or additional needs (if applicable). Sharing specific requirements helps the school plan and ensure these needs are met.
Family Court Order or Restricted Access documentation	Any Court Order involving the student should accompany the application (if applicable).
Suspensions	Information relating to previous school suspensions (if applicable).
Other Useful Information	Your child's most current school report (if applicable).
